WINDY DAY RECYCLING TIPS

Recycling and trash collection can be very challenging on windy days. And while we can't control Mother Nature, the following tips can help prevent your trash/ recycling from blowing away.

Bundle cardboard, newspapers, and magazines separately, place these bundled items on top of the lighter items in your recycling container.

Need more space, step on cartons, deflate aluminum and water bottles. Stand paper products up on edge, this saves a lot of space and helps to reduce the possibility or items blowing out of your recycling container on windy days.

Don't overfill your recycling container, keep material below the rim to prevent wind from blowing recyclables out of your container.

Place your recycling container at the curb the morning of collection day, rather than the evening before. This will reduce the amount of time your container is exposed to windy conditions.

Half full container, consider holding your recycling back until the next weeks collection.
